Our staff has developed a school-wide literacy and numeracy program for students of all levels. This will be administered during homeroom time (the first twenty minutes of each day).






### **School Expectations**

- School starts at 7:55 am. sharp and you are expected to be in class at 7:55 a.m.






# Dress Code Policy
